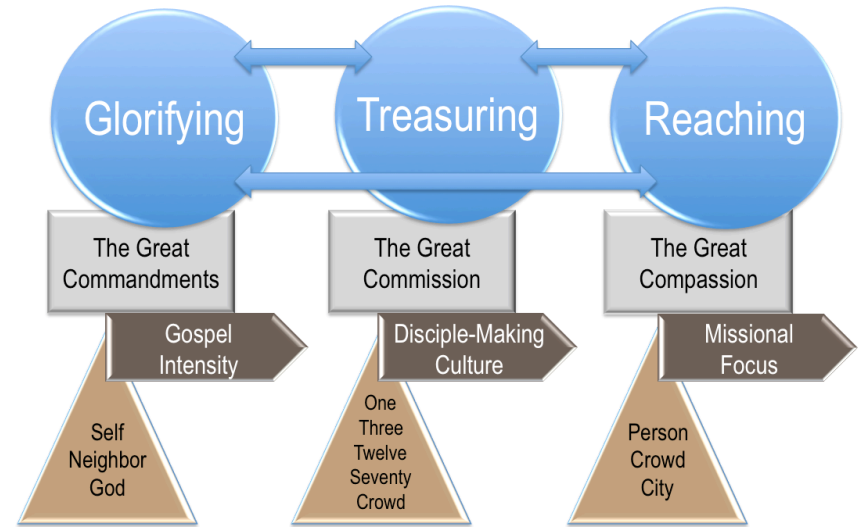


Our Passion Revisited
