## MISSION OPPORTUNITIES

### Boulder-Family Mission Trip: July 18-24

**Scope** - We will be partnering with East Boulder Baptist in leading a VBS for the community. This is a great opportunity to lead your family on mission as we build relationships with other families of UBC and continue to impact Boulder with the Gospel and encourage the churches and church plants engaging this city.

**Cost & Team Size** - The approximate cost is \$600 per family and \$400 per individual. The team size is open.

### Colombia: August 29-September 5

**Scope** - We will be serving the children and staff of La Aljaba Children's Home demonstrating and displaying the love of Christ within it's ministry. Part of this team will go out on the Amazon with the Burkhalters in reaching the unreached villages and encouraging one of UBC's missionary families.

**Cost & Team Size** - The approximate cost is \$2000 per person. The team size is 8-10 individuals.

### Deserts of Africa: Fall Date - TBD

**Scope** - We will continue to partner with Joshua & Kayla and Joseph in reaching the B People. This trip will involve friendship evangelism and Bible storying with the B People, discipling new believers, and meeting physical needs through dental care.

**Cost & Team Size** - The approximate cost is \$2000 per person. The team size is 4-6 individuals.

### Oaxaca: October 25-31

**Scope** - We will be partnering with Kerry and Mauri Johnson as we continue our reach into Oaxaca, both along the coast and in mountainous villages. The trip will include evangelism, discipleship and agricultural projects.


**Cost & Team Size** - The approximate cost is \$1800 per person. The team size is 10 individuals.

## SENT OVER SPRING BREAK

A bowl of beans and rice, a canoe, & rakes and hedge trimmers. The vehicle of the Gospel looked a whole lot different for each of our teams sent out over Spring Break, but nevertheless, the message of the Gospel was unchanging as they lived life on mission.

30 of our folks, including 19 of the Middle and UBSM student ministries served The Well in Boulder. This church plant, which we've been partnered with for the last handful of years, has now expanded to two services, and for the second Easter in a row has met in the Boulder Theater as



their reach continues to expand. Our team served the The Well members and their staff, as well as their neighborhoods by laboring in hands-on projects throughout the week.

We also sent three of our young professionals to

Colombia to extend the ministry of the Burkhalters reaching the indigenous on the Amazon River. They led sessions of Bible storying in villages, while also encouraging the believers, including one who came out of a life of drug trafficking over a year ago.

We also had a team of six serve the Tugwells and their ministry of Outside the Bowl, coupled with Child Hope reaching into the lives of orphans in Haiti.

## Logan McCollough/Chad McCone - Hands On E. Asia

Football as a front door to the Gospel, for two friends, whom God has led their stories together on a collision course for seeing the Gospel extend into E. Asia. Chad McCone and Logan McCollough, who served as high school football teammates in Huntsville, will be serving together with the IMB Hands On program in E. Asia from July 4 - January 6, 2016.



They will be in a city of 14 million with 500,000 college students teaching English to young kids and university students, while also coaching and playing football with one of our partners who uses this platform as a means of sharing Christ.

We pray that this will be the first of a pipeline of students that we will see engaging university campuses in this urban center. Also, we pray that this will propel us towards a greater work of our next adopted unreached people group just north of this city - a people group numbering 5 million with few believers and little to no access to the Gospel.
